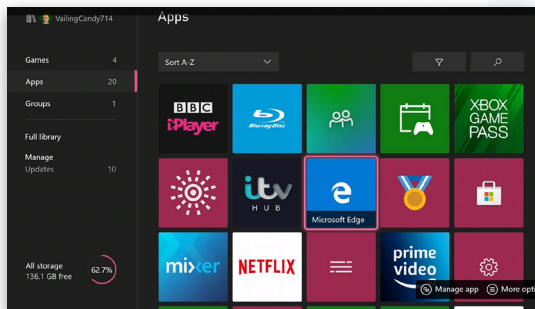


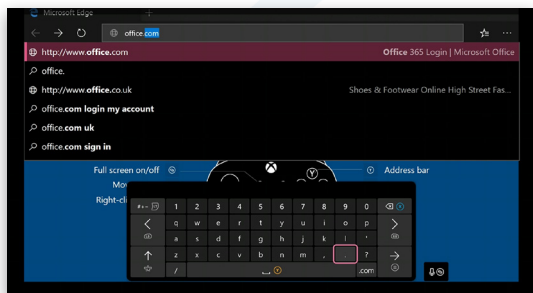
# Accessing Teams with an X-Box: Using the Edge Browser

## Step 1: Choose Edge from the Apps Page



From the X-Box main page, select **Games** and **Apps**. Choose the Apps section from the left-hand menu. You should see the **Edge Browser** logo in the Apps icon list. Move the selector over the app and press the X button on the controller.

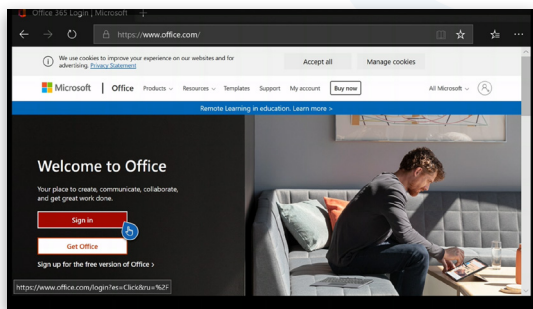
## Step 2: Log in to office.com



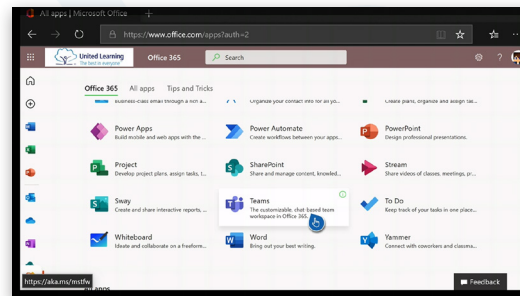
Enter 'Office.com' into the Address Bar. Use the onscreen keyboard and the suggested URLs list to help. NB: Although you can attach a USB Keyboard to an X-Box, you will have to use a controller as a mouse. A screen appears showing you how to use a controller to browse:



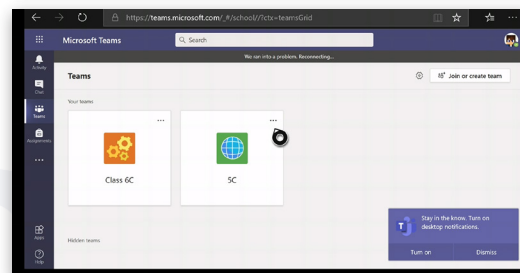
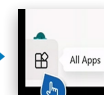
When the office login screen appears, choose to **Sign In**.



## Step 3: Navigate Teams in the Browser



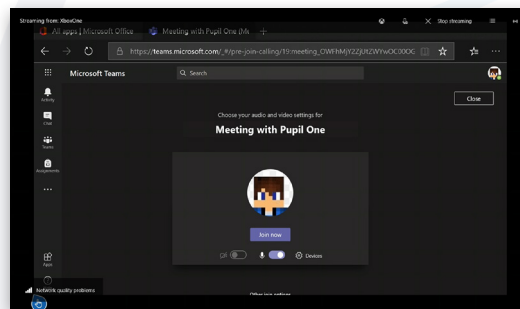
The office screen will load, but you may not see Teams in the left-hand icon menu. If you don't see Teams available, then choose the **All Apps** icon at the bottom of the menu to reveal Teams in the list.



The Teams interface will appear, and the normal arrangement of tools and icons will appear, allowing you to access your class teams and assignments.

## Step 4: Accessing Live Lessons

You can access Live Meetings from posts in the class noticeboard.



NB: The default connection to a live meeting will not include a camera function (unless you have a separate webcam plugged into your X-Box). However, you can see other people who have cameras on during the meeting, and use your microphone.
